## **Celestial Dances**

*Celestial Dances* (1991) was written specifically for my friend and colleague at Washington State University, David Jarvis. Bearing in mind his background in jazz as well as classical music, I set out to write a piece that would balance atonal moments with freely tonal ones, ametric passages with those that are metric and syncopated. Other balances occur between highly directed 'goaloriented' passages and those of a more eastern, minimalist design, as well as traditional devices like canon set against nontraditional devices like timbral development. Conceived originally from a graphic score, the tape incorporates analog, digital, and sampled sounds; the score and recording are published by Music for Percussion, Inc.
